Christian Caprara studied biology at the University of Zurich. After his PhD at the Lab for Retinal Cell Biology at USZ/UZH he joined the Swiss Stem Cell Foundation in Gentilino/TI. One of their goals is to develop strategies for the differentiation of adipose-derived stem cells into osteocytes and cardiomyocytes by an interdisciplinary approach that integrates stem cell biology and biomaterial sciences.

Micha Häuptle studied biochemistry at the ETH and graduated 2009 at the University of Zurich. After characterizing several new diseases of protein glycosylation during his PhD, he joined the biotech company GlycoVaxyn, which develops new types of carbohydrate-based vaccines.
